Aqua Camps, run by the Bermuda Zoological Society (BZS), are week-long, full-day (9am-3pm) natural history camps which give children the opportunity to have positive experiences learning about nature. They offer hands-on education, field trips, arts and crafts, and Zoo/Aquarium visits and are based at the Bermuda Aquarium, Museum & Zoo (BAMZ). The camps are divided into age groups based on the child's **current year in school**. All activities are geared for the appropriate age group.

Children may attend our traditional aqua camps for <u>one week only</u>. Please see our new Aqua Freediving Camp application as children may attend one week of freediving camp as well. Freediving weeks are included below for your information.

Aqua Camp Themes for 2018

Thank you for your interest in our Aqua Camp programme. Our Aqua Kids, Fun, Zoo and Explorer camps use a two year alternating curriculum that takes children through a series of life science and Bermuda natural history topics. This year's themes are:

- Aqua Tots campers will learn about different animal groups and plants.
- Aqua Kids campers will learn about Bermuda's original and present-day forests, their inhabitants and their importance for wildlife.
- Aqua Fun campers will learn about Bermuda's beaches, their inhabitants, their importance and what is threatening them.
- Aqua Zoo campers will learn about the life cycle of our local sea turtles and the seagrass beds they depend on and how both are being threatened.
- Aqua Explorers camp will take place on Trunk Island and campers will be exploring issues from the book 'World Without Fish' as well as experiencing an array of marine and aquatic habitats across the island.
- Aqua Conservationists a five-day residential camp based on Trunk Island. Campers will volunteer in the zoo/aquarium and explore and participate in a variety of conservation projects.

A list of what your child needs to bring to camp will be emailed to you in mid-June. Prior to your child starting camp, you will be emailed a schedule of their daily activities. This will not be posted on the web site for security reasons.

Aqua Camp 2018 Application Instructions

Please take note of the following when completing the application:

- · Complete a separate form for each child.
- Children may attend for **one week** only with the exception of Aqua Tots which may attend one week in July and one week in August (children may also attend a week of the appropriate freediving camp).
- Please complete the 'Health/Special Needs' section on page 2 as fully as possible.
- The 'Disclaimer' on page 2 must be signed by a parent/guardian in order for the application to be accepted.
- If your child has a friend they want to be with in camp this must be noted in the 'Requests/Comments' box.
- Full payment of camp fee must accompany your application. A non-refundable application fee of \$15/child is included in the camp fee.
- Aqua Camps are available only to members of the Bermuda Zoological Society (BZS) or the Atlantic Conservation Partnership (ACP).
- If you do not have a current membership, use the form on page 3 to join or renew. The membership fee must accompany your application.
- The parent(s) or grandparent(s) of the child(ren) applying must have a minimum of a Killifish (Family or Grandparent) level membership which must be valid until December 31, 2018 at the time of application.
