Group Volunteer Policy

Groups accepted for volunteer placement will be sent a document defining the volunteer project(s) prior to the start date of the stated project(s).

Group Volunteers must identify a Group Contact prior to the start of a project who will serve responsible for the safety and wellbeing of all group members.

- 1. To provide coordination and supervision for group while volunteering.
- 2. To ensure all members adhere to BZS and BAMZ rules and procedures.

(Youth Groups - only)

Volunteers must be at least 14 years of age.

Volunteer opportunities for youth aged 14 to 18 years of age are limited. A responsible adult must accompany volunteers under the age of 18 at all times during the stated period of service work. You must provide a 1:5 adult to youth ratio.

Group Volunteer Agreement

It is the responsibility of the coordinating group to obtain a signed parental consent form for group members under the age of 18, which must be brought to the project day by the Group Coordinator who will retain them in case of emergency.

- 1. We agree to volunteer our time and talents to assist the Bermuda Zoological Society(BZS) in carrying out its mission.
- 2. We agree to:
 - a. Complete the duties that we agree and are assigned to do to the best of our ability.
 - b. Arrive on time and notify staff when we are unable to work the shift or hours we had planned.
